Departure time

Long Walk

Will start at Victoria Park car park in Arbroath and follow the coastal path North to Auchmithie and on to Lunan Bay Beach car park. There are 2 short ascents of about 100 feet - one down and up to the beach to get around Seaton Den and the other off the beach at Lunan Bay to Red Jock's castle

Distance 10.7 miles.

Short Walk

The bus will drop you off at the clifftop village of Auchmithie to follow the coastal path to Arbroath.

Distance 6.0 miles.
